## **Information for Authors**

- All papers submitted to the XXIII COMRob 2021 must be written in English or Spanish and formatted in standard two-column format, following the IEEE for conferences format.
- Papers written in English or Spanish will be considered for publication in the proceedings of the **XXIII COMRob 2021**, which will have ISBN registration.
- Best evaluated papers, written in English or Spanish, will have the option of presenting an extended version to be published in the **AMRob Journal: Theory and Applications**, with ISSN registration.
- The Technical Program Committee start the process in IEEE with the end that best qualified English written papers could be considered for publication in <u>IEEE Xplore Digital Library</u>. On the other hand, Spanish written papers, also best evaluated and with the abstract written in English, will be considered for the same database. In both cases, the papers must use <u>IEEE PDF eXpress</u> (IEEE CrossCheck antiplagiarism checker included) in order to have the format requested by IEEE Xplore.
- All papers will undergo a peer review process for its acceptance. Further, articles **must be formatted for** "**blind**" **review**, that is, they should **NOT** contain any type of information about the authors or their institutions. These data will be added in the final version, once the paper is accepted.
- The papers must be submitted through the **OPENCONF** platform.
- All papers must be sent in **PDF** format with the information requested by the system.
- All papers are limited to 6 pages.
- If the paper is accepted, at least one of the authors must be registered as a speaker and submit the paper according to the conference submission deadline.
- If the paper is accepted, at least one of the authors listed on the paper must attend the conference and present the paper according to the scheduling decided by the conference's Technical Program Committee. In the event that the speaker is unable to attend the conference for any reason, it is his/her responsibility to ensure that the paper is presented by a qualified colleague.
